Getting to South False Creek on Sunday, April 19th

The **42nd annual Vancouver Sun Run** will take place in the streets of Vancouver on the morning of Sunday, April 19th. In 2025 over 50,000 runners, joggers, walkers and wheelchair participants registered to run and this year we hope to have over 50,000 participants join us and complete this beautiful 10K course.

The Vancouver Sun Run starts at 8:50am for Wheelchair participants and at 9:00am for all other participants. The start line is located on Georgia Street between Burrard and Thurlow. The EVA Air Mini Sun, which is a family friendly non-timed 2.5K run, begins at 8:00am on Pacific Boulevard at Griffiths Way. Both courses will be lined with water stations and will have musical entertainment. The finish line is on Pacific Boulevard near Griffiths Way.

The Vancouver Sun Run post-race party is inside BC Place Stadium and is open to the public.

City of Vancouver Road closures will be in effect along the 10K and 2.5K routes and the Vancouver Police will be directing traffic. Road Closure information and route maps can be found online at www.vanoutersunrun.com

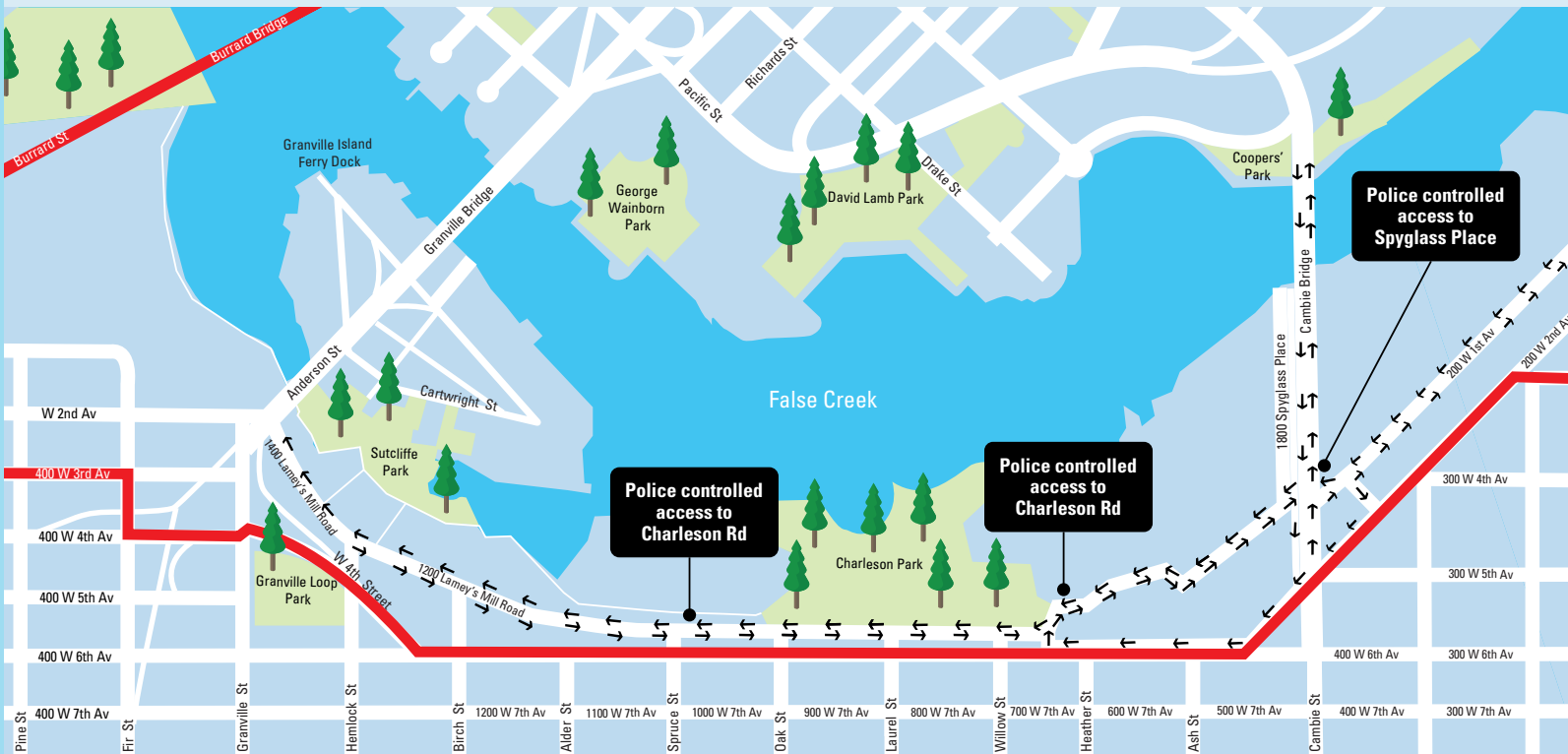
